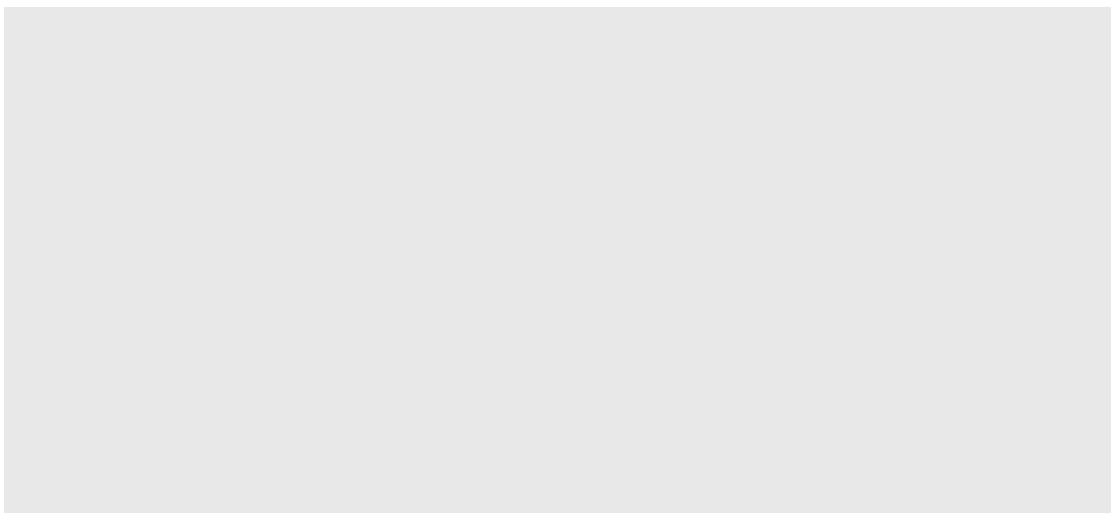

The State legislature session will be held at Suvarna Soudha in Belagavi from December 9 to 20.


The Cabinet meeting, presided over by Chief Minister Siddaramaiah, ^{ADVERTISEMENT} took the decision to hold the 10-day session in the border city, here on Wednesday. It also decided to hold a Cabinet meeting in Kalaburagi on November 27.

Briefing presspersons, Law and Parliamentary Affairs Minister T.B. Jayachandra said the Cabinet deferred the discussion on the proposal to ban the sale of tobacco-chewing products. "We decided to wait till the verdict of the Supreme Court, which is hearing a petition," Mr. Jayachandra said.

He reiterated the government's commitment to protect the interests of areca and tobacco growers. The areca price had fallen about 30 per cent already after rumours about an impending ban on tobacco-chewing products, he said.

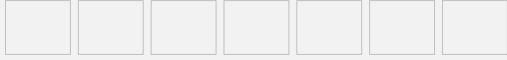
