

GURGAON: The ban on hookah bars in Gurgaon, Faridabad and Panchkula five months ago might not have gone down well with many youngsters, but the World Health Organisation (WHO) now wants all other states, including Delhi, to do the same. In a recent meeting on âTobacco Control Actâ, the multilateral agency had appreciated the statewide campaign undertaken by the Haryana government in the last two months of 2011. National professional officer of Tobacco Free Initiative (WHO) in India, Vineet Gill Munish, said the campaign to prohibit the use of nicotine in hookah bars has been very effective. She said similar campaigns should be started in other metropolitan cities where more youths have started visiting hookah bars. In fact, early this month, a similar campaign was launched in Mumbai and several young men and women were asked to empty such bars. Taking a step ahead to continue the campaign despite reports of several business entities trying to resume the operation of the hookah bars, the government has constituted a state-level task force under the chairmanship of chief secretary. Similar committees have been formed at the district level . aThe task force keeps vigil on the activities of the bars by conducting raids frequently. Besides, legal action was also being taken against the owners of the bars for violating the norms, â an official statement said. The Gurgaon district administration had banned all hookah bars invoking Section 144 of the CrPC. The administration had claimed that hookah bars were serving tobacco molasses containing nicotine which is injurious to health, especially to acollege students and youthsa. There were close to 60 hookah bars in the city. The district administration had swung in to action weeks after the stateas food and drugs administration (FDA) wing had conducted a series of raids on such bars in Gurgaon, Faridabad, Rohtak and Panipat, and had lifted 77 samples from these bars. However, it as not just hookah, which is posing greater health problem to youths in the state. The bigger problem is consumption of tobacco by a large section of the stateas population. Addressing at the workshop, state director general of health services Dr Narvir Singh said that till date 2,163 public places have been raided and 9,189 persons have been challaned for smoking in public places. A fine of over Rs 6.21 lakh has been collected from them.
