Bengaluru: The state cabinet on Wednesday deferred ban on tobacco and decided to amend the Indian Succession Act, 1925 in accordance with the recommendations of the <u>Law Commission</u> of India. The existing Act does not allow automatic transfer of ownership or succession to anyone named in the will if the owner of an immovable property dies when a case is pending in court. According to the proposed amendment, the ownership will be transferred to the person named in the will, and the case in court will continue. Another section provides for state government to exempt any race, sect or tribe from the Act.

Speaking to reporters after the meeting, law and parliamentary affairs minister TB Jayachandra said the amendments will be made as per the recommendations of the law commission. About the decision not to ban tobacco for now, he said, âKarnataka alone cannot ban tobacco in any form. The matter is in the <u>Supreme Court</u> and we are awaiting its verdict.âThere has been a campaign to ban tobacco in the state. According to him, even if Karnataka banned tobacco, the product would come from neighbouring states. âNo state has the power to ban trade and transit of states. Tobacco in all forms â chewing, gutka, beedi and cigarette â should be banned across the country,â he said. Other decisions: \*Cabinet rejects Lokayuktaâs recommendations for action against IPS officer C Chandrashekar and education department deputy director SK Channabasappa, charged with misconduct. \*Dismisses commercial tax officer (CTO) HP Venkatesh on the recommendation of Lokayukta. The officer was caught by the Lokayukta accepting bribe. \*Decides to hold winter session of legislature in Belagavi from December 9 to December 20. \*Allots 84.38 acres in Somathahalli village near Devanahalli to Indian Navy for construction of a base. \*Decides to give 19 tourism department hotels and restaurants to private players for upgrade and maintenance. \*Decides to hold special cabinet meeting at Gulbarga in Hyderabad-Karnataka region on November 27.
